Our day







'Don't you have any homework this evening?' their mother asked.


'Not tonight, Mum,' they answered. 'We did lots of work at school. We can play now!'

When they were tired they watched TV and then they went to bed to read their books at 8 o'clock with a glass of milk. They went to sleep at 9 o' clock.




